Pathways to College asks each member of its community to commit himself or herself to the principles below. *This mutual commitment is key to the success of the program.*

Pathways directors and partners make the following commitments to the program and its participants.

As a director of the Pathways to College program **I WILL:**

- Maintain a loving, Christian atmosphere.
 - Remain committed to Biblical principles.
 - Strive to witness those principles in all that I do.
 - Provide a Christian perspective throughout the program.
- Promote students' academic success.
 - Help students with their academic needs.
 - Encourage students to exceed expectations.
 - Become a mentor and be open to questions.
- Provide financial options for the students' future college careers.
 - Provide information on types of financial aid available
 - Work with students and their parents regarding financial needs.
 - Be willing to help find an affordable college.
- Be accessible to Pathways students and parents whenever needed.
 - Ensure prompt response to all e-mails and telephone calls.
 - Be open and readily available to answer all questions.
 - Reserve time to meet individually with students and/or parents if needed.

Pathways students are asked to commit to these principles as a condition of participation.

As a student in the Pathways to College program **I WILL:**

- Do everything in my power to ensure my success and that of my fellow students by adhering to the program's expectations.
 - Attend all Pathways activities (minimum of 80% attendance).
 - Engage in the activities offered.
 - Encourage others to exceed the expectations of the program.
- Strive to exhibit Christ-like behavior in all that I do.
 - Respect myself and others at all times.
 - Be willing to help others when possible.
 - Let my light shine for Christ through my attitude.
 - Be ethical in all that I do.
- Stay on task with my own academic career.
 - Work diligently on all assignments.
 - Turn in all work promptly and do not procrastinate.
 - Ask teachers, parents, or tutors for assistance when needed.
- Maintain open communication with my parents and those involved with the Pathways program.
 - Ask for help when needed.
 - Ask and answer questions freely.
 - Be an active participant.

As a parent /guardian in the Pathways to College program **I WILL:**

- Do everything in my power to promote a loving Christian household.
 - Develop and/or maintain open communication with my child.
